PROPOSED MEETING PROCEDURES LOCAL LAW 2021

In accordance with Section 3.12 of the Local Government Act 1995 public notice is given that the Tamala Park Regional Council proposes to make the Tamala Park Regional Council Meeting Procedures Local Law 2021. This will replace the Tamala Park Regional Council Standing Orders Local Law 2006 which will be repealed once the replacement local law is gazetted.

The purpose of the proposed Tamala Park Regional Council Meeting Procedures Local Law 2021 is to provide the rules that apply to the conduct of meetings of the Council and its committees.

The effect of the proposed Tamala Park Regional Council Meeting Procedures Local Law 2021 is intended to result in:

- a) better decision making by the Council and its committees
- b) the orderly conduct of meetings dealing with Council business
- c) better understanding of the process of conducting meetings
- d) more efficient and effective use of time at meetings.
